Dear Peter,

I am writing to thank you for your donation of £900 representing the left-over cash following the closure of the Association of Yoga Practitioners. Thank you for choosing to donate the money you have raised to Amnesty International. Please pass on my thanks to the other former members of the Association of Yoga Practitioners.

The work you have helped fund makes a massive difference to people's lives. People like Albert Woodfox who was held in solitary confinement in the US for 43-years in conditions the UN described as torture. Albert and another inmate were charged with the murder of a prison guard in 1972. The conviction was secured after an unfair trial and was overturned 3-times before Albert was finally released last year. Amnesty believe the charges against him were politically motivated.

After his release, Albert told us: **"Amnesty gave us international exposure and support. We were fortunate when the world embraced us. Because of the hard work of organisations like Amnesty, we were given a voice."**


Thank you so much for your kind gift of £800.00 – you've helped someone take the next step towards a brighter future.
